This budget is for the Murrieta Service Area. The wastewater from the majority of the customers in the service area is treated by Rancho California Water District's (RCWD) wastewater treatment facility. Wastewater from the remaining customers (about 50) is treated by Eastern Municipal Water District's (EMWD) wastewater treatment facility. Western passes through the per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU) charge from RCWD and from EMWD to its customers and adds on a \$5.50 per EDU service charge to pay for lateral maintenance, billing expenses and establishment of a reserve to pay debt service (\$4.50 per EDU for EMWD customers).
