



Irrigation Controller Exemption Form

If your irrigation controller is on the **Irrigation Association’s Smart Water Application Technology (SWAT)** list, you are not required to follow the run-time and irrigation day requirements during Stages 2 through 4, but like all other irrigators, you are required to follow time of day requirements. There is no exemption from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. watering restrictions. To check if your irrigation controller is eligible please go to irrigation.org and click the “SWAT Controller Reports” link on the front page or find the SWAT link on our website, wmwd.com.

Definition of Smart Controller: Smart controllers estimate or measure depletion of available plant soil moisture in order to operate an irrigation system, replenishing water as needed while minimizing excess water use. A properly programmed smart controller requires initial site specific set-up and will make irrigation schedule adjustments, including run times and required cycles, throughout the irrigation season without human intervention.
