Division 4

Has served on the Board since January 2005. Division 4 consists of Jurupa; Mira Loma; Glen Avon; Rubidoux; most of Norco; a section of Corona north of the 91 freeway and east of the 15 freeway; a section of the city of Riverside north of the 91 freeway and west of Pierce Street to La Sierra.



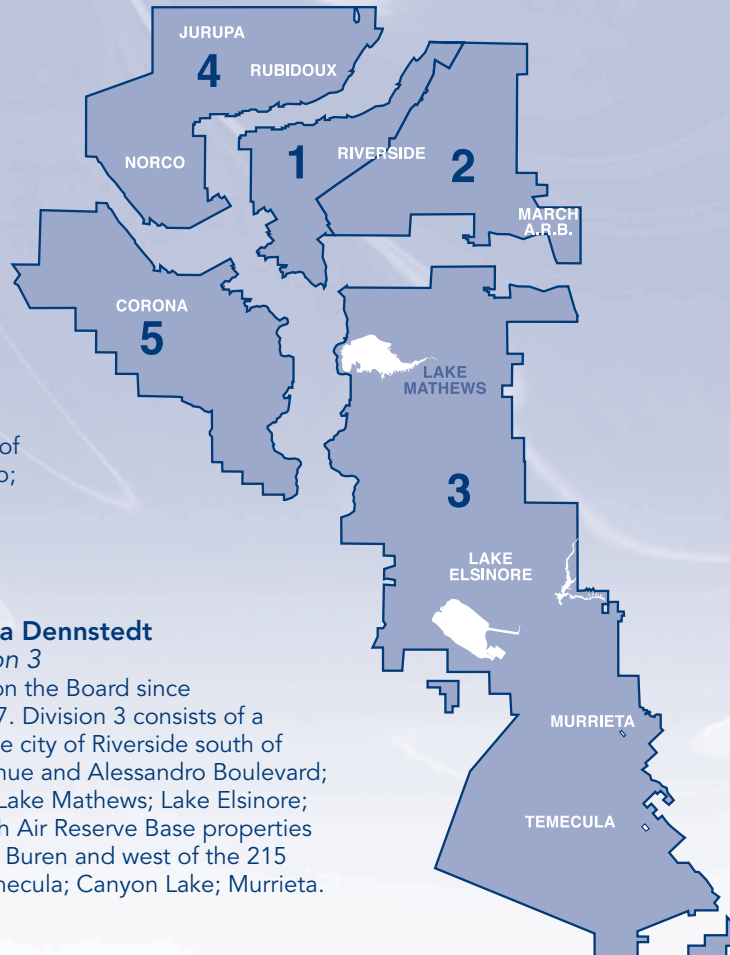
1 **Charles D. Field**
Division 1

Has served on the Board since January 2007. Division 1 consists of a portion of the city of Riverside south of the Santa Ana River and north of Magnolia to the San Bernardino County line; Lake Hills.



5 **S. R. "Al" Lopez**
Division 5

Has served on the Board since January 2001. Division 5 consists of Corona; Home Gardens; El Cerrito; Temescal; a portion of Norco.



2 **Thomas P. Evans**
Division 2

Has served on the Board since January 2007. Division 2 consists of a portion of the city of Riverside south of Magnolia and north of Victoria Avenue and Alessandro Boulevard; March Air Reserve Base.



3 **Brenda Dennstedt**
Division 3

Has served on the Board since January 2007. Division 3 consists of a portion of the city of Riverside south of Victoria Avenue and Alessandro Boulevard; Woodcrest; Lake Mathews; Lake Elsinore; former March Air Reserve Base properties south of Van Buren and west of the 215 freeway; Temecula; Canyon Lake; Murrieta.



The five members of the Board of Directors comprise the governing body of the District and are responsible for setting public policy.

The Directors, individually and collectively, are responsible to the members of the public of his or her division, and to the general public within the District, for proper conduct of District affairs.

Board members are elected to four-year terms by the registered voters in the five geographical divisions of

the District. These divisions are apportioned by population. Terms are staggered to ensure continuity, with public elections held in at least two divisions every two years. The Directors must reside in the division from which he or she is elected.

The Board meets the first and third Wednesday of each month at 9:30 a.m. in Western's Board Room at 450 E. Alessandro Boulevard in Riverside. The public is welcome. Any member of the public who wishes to address the Directors at a Board meeting may do so during the portion of the meeting set aside for public comment.
