Anything ushered into the collection drain from local drains isn't treated at a sewer plant, eventually trickling in local creeks, waterways, rivers and oceans to impact aquatic life.

To protect the environment:

- Don't overwater lawns or wash down pavements
- Limit fertilizer, weed abatement chemicals and pesticide applications to your lawn
- It's illegal to dump trash and hazardous materials such as car oil in storm drains
